NOTICE OF RACE 2009

1 RULES

The Regatta shall be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, and as modified by the issued Sailing Instructions.

* DECISION TO RACE

All those taking part in races conducted by the Port Lincoln Yacht Club do so at their own risk and responsibility. Attention is drawn to **Fundamental Rule 4** - "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

* ENTRY

A minimum of six (6) nominations for each class will be necessary before races will be conducted for that class. Four (4) starters must contest the first race of any class during the Regatta. In subsequent races, three (3) starters will be necessary to contest that race.
Classes not having sufficient starters for a class shall be placed in a " Yardstick" division.

Postal entries shall Friday 3 April 2009 and shall be accompanied by the required entry fee.
Late entries may be accepted but shall incur a \$10 late entry fee.
The Port Lincoln Yacht Club reserves the right to refuse entry.

* ELIGIBILITY

(a) The helms person must be a current financial member, and comply to the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing Rule 46, "PERSON IN CHARGE".

(b) All crew/persons refer to the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing Rule 55, "Except in an International event, any crew member that sails in more than 3 races in any one sailing season, shall be a member of a club affiliated to an MYA and Yachting Australia". (ie. Youth, Silver or Gold member)

* **RACING AREA /COURSES**

Courses will be displayed on the board at the Race Committee area approximately 1 hour prior to the WARNING SIGNAL of the first class.

A Course description will be issued with the Sailing Instructions.
The course rounding marks shall be advised and posted on official notice board at the briefing.

* **SCORING**

The Low Scoring System as defined in appendix "A" – Scoring (A4 – Lowpoint) will apply.
The series will consist of six (6) races. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

* **HANDICAPS:** - Shall be calculated by Port Lincoln Yacht Club.

* **PRIZES**

Shall be awarded depending upon class entry numbers & is accordance with the SGYA Constitution.
The Presentation will be at approx 1930 hrs Sunday 12th April at the Port Lincoln Yacht Club

* **ADVERTISING**

The Regatta is classified as a Category "C" event in accordance with Appendix 1 ISAF Advertising code.

* **SUPPORT CRAFT**

Any craft are requested to keep clear of competitors during the race events & casual support must cease upon the Warning Signal.
Support craft are requested not to use radio communication during the race events, unless directed by the P.R.O. or during an Emergency.
